**Munich Lager:** A bready, malt-forward "Oktoberfest". Crisp but with more body than most lagers.

**IPA:** A hop-forward, tropical IPA. Tropical fruit flavors from Mosaic, Citra and Simcoe hops pair well with the oats and wheat in the malt bill.

**Belgian Amber:** The Belgian yeast imparts banana and other fruity aromas to this malty, full-bodied but session strength Dubbel.

## Safety

### Wildlife Safety at Kincaid:

Kincaid Park is frequented by moose & bears. If you see a moose, do not approach it. Moose can charge, especially if they are in the presence of their young and/or feel threatened. Although less frequent than moose, bear sightings at Kincaid are not uncommon. If you are unfamiliar with what to do if a bear approaches you, please take it upon yourself to read up. Additionally, please exercise common sense regarding where you store food overnight in bear country. Food should be stored in vehicles, not tents. If you have personal food but no vehicle to store it in, please contact any tournament organizer. We will find a bear-safe location for your food! Stay with a group when walking or biking around the park - especially in the evening. Bear spray is a good precaution.

**Theft:** Kincaid Park is very isolated and we will have the whole place to ourselves at night. Compared to our previous JAM location (Davis Park in Mountain View), Kincaid should be relatively safe. However, do not leave valuables in the cars, especially during the day when the gates are open.

**Saturday night departures:** We encourage all party attendees to camp at the fields. The gates will close at 10 pm. We will open the Raspberry road gate one time, at midnight, for people to exit if needed. A gate-opening announcement will be made at the party. Or better yet, park at the Raspberry Parking lot, ride your bike and leave whenever you like.

### Kincaid parking & gate logistics

**Parking:** All tournament attendees must park at the lower parking lot near the stadium, NOT the chalet lot (see map). Frisbee central is approx. 1/4 miles from the parking area - consider bringing a wagon. If you need to drop stuff off at the fields prior to parking, there is an access road near the chalet. We have a key to this gate.

**Kincaid park gate:** Kincaid Park closes to the public at 10 pm. At that time, the gate located at the Raspberry road parking lot will be locked. The tournament organizers have a key.

**Friday arrivals:** If you arrive before 10 pm, the Raspberry gate will be open. If you want to get past the gate on Friday night, you MUST arrive before 10 pm UNLESS one of two situations

applies to you: (1) you are driving to Anchorage and will not arrive until after 10 pm, or (2) you are arriving by plane and your flight arrives later in the evening. IF and only IF you fall into these exceptions, you need to contact Hazel by Thursday to make arrangements. If you arrive after 10 pm and have not made prior arrangements you can park at the Raspberry road lot and bike or walk in to the fields - about 1.5 miles.

**Saturday/Sunday morning arrivals:** Gate will open at 8:15 am for morning arrivals and will remain open until 10 am when the park opens to the public.

**NOTICE:** There is very poor cell phone reception in Kincaid - especially at the fields.

## Camping & showers

## Tournament Rules

**1** Except where otherwise stated, we will run under USA Ultimate's 11th edition rules.

**2** Teams designate an endzone at the beginning of each game for choosing gender ratio. Saturday: Play should be 4-3 or 3-4, 5-2 is discouraged but can be determined between captains at start of game. Sunday: Championship bracket teams must play 4-3 or 3-4.

**3** Games are to 13. Quarters, semis & finals games are to 15.

**4** One timeout per half plus one floater. Timeouts that are called when a team has none left will result in a turnover.

**5** No soft cap. Hard cap will be sounded after 80 minutes. Finish point and if tied, play one more. Quarters & semis will have a soft cap after 75 minutes, hard cap at 85 minutes. Finals will not be capped.
